The **Opening Session** on 8 October coincides with the plenary session of the Committee of the Regions and the European Parliament's Regional Development Committee's meeting. This will kick off the 10th edition of OPEN DAYS, with its 108 workshops organised in Brussels from 9 to 11 October.

This year's OPEN DAYS will be held during a period of debate in the European Parliament, the Council, the Member States and the regions on the Multiannual Financial Framework 2014-2020 and the future cohesion policy.
