You are responsible for the people management of the planning team, their work environment and also have budgetary responsibility for the Planning Department. You are also responsible for both short and long-term mining planning, surveying, geology and grade control. The work means that you are responsible for an area under constant change that places high demands on safety awareness and safety. Direct reports include six geologists and two field technicians[LA1] .

As mining planning manager, you lead the work within the department, which includes the development of mining and drilling plans, measurement work, the preparation of the mining plans and hedging/fuse materials?, updating of block models and ore base optimizations, geology and content control, and production follow-up against the plans.[LA2]
